



The Clore Ballroom

Located within Level 2 of the Royal Festival Hall building, The Clore Ballroom is the largest Ballroom in the UK. The Ballroom can only be hired for events on rare occasions, and its private use necessitates partial closure of the Royal Festival Hall building.

Capacities	Standing reception – 800 Seated dinner – 450
Air conditioned	No
Lighting	Lighting truss fixed to ceiling with a number of lights attached which can be accessed via Southbank Centre Production dept. Lots of natural light due to floor-to-ceiling windows and full black-out curtains for balcony. Access to 3 phase power.
Furniture available	N/A
Finishes	Wooden floor, open light feel to space, floor-to-ceiling windows. The Ballroom Floor contains 8 large pillars, which may affect sight lines.
Additional/associated spaces	With partial building closure, The Clore Ballroom also has access to the Level 2 side foyers and Central Bar area which can be used as overspill from the Ballroom, pre-dinner reception space, exhibition space etc.
Outside space	None
Access	Disabled access onto the Ballroom via a ramp from Level 2 foyers. Equipment can be brought in via Goods Lift to Level 2.
Toilets	On Level 2 foyer and either side of cloakroom.
